1. Call Meeting to Order.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Brenda Clark at 6:00 pm .

2. Public participation.

Directors voting in favor were Brenda Clark, Carol Cote, Sandy LaBelle, Lisa Martin and Brien Walker. Director voting against was Tony Goulet. Chair declared the motion passed 5 votes to 1.

7. Consideration of an increase to substitute teacher pay for Ashland District School.

A motion was made by Tony Goulet, seconded by Sandy LaBelle, to approve the increase for substitute teacher pay to \$90 for Ashland District School. Chair declared the vote was unanimous.
