Dear Students, Families, and Staff,

We are writing to inform you that a person affiliated with Ashland District School (ADS) has tested positive for the coronavirus (COVID-19).

Members of the MSAD #32 Health Services department are in the process of isolating and notifying the students and staff members considered close contacts to the individual who tested positive for the coronavirus. We have approximately 3 students and 3 staff members at ADS who are considered close contacts. The quarantine recommendation is ten days from last possible contact with the individual who tested positive for COVID. These close contacts will be out of ten-day quarantine on Monday, April 19 and welcomed back at ADS after April vacation on Monday, April 26.

Since we have only three staff members and three students considered close contacts at ADS, **the school will remain open for in-person instruction and will maintain our regular schedules.**

MSAD #32 officials have been in contact with the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and are following the protocols and procedures outlined for schools to follow when a case of the coronavirus occurs in a school. The CDC recommends that close contacts of a person who tests positive for the coronavirus should quarantine for 10 days.

COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that ranges from mild to severe. The virus mainly spreads when an infected person coughs or sneezes and an uninfected person breathes in the virus. Signs and symptoms include:

- fever or chills • cough • shortness of breath or difficulty breathing • fatigue
- muscle or body aches • headache • sore throat • new loss of taste or smell
- congestion or runny nose • nausea or vomiting • diarrhea
